There are 2 more meetings for Moapa: October 18th and January 23rd

2. Nevada Department of Wildlife Muddy River Update (for discussion only)

Since 2010 they have been working to eliminate the invasive non-native tilapia. Lasts year's efforts (northern boundary of Paiute to the NV Energy plant ending at Hidden Valley Rd. crossing) have shown positive results and the native fish have begun bringing their numbers back up to a stable count. Plans are set forth to work on the next phase of the river during the first week of November. The next phase will begin at the Hidden Valley barrier to Willow Siding (where the diversion to the Bowman Reservoir is) and will include the Meadow Valley and California Wash. The pesticide (odorless and colorless) used attacks gilled species and signs will be up to notify people where not to swim during the time of treatment. Staff will detoxify the river downstream from the treated area which is purple in color but nontoxic. In order to avoid native fish being poisoned, staff will work the month prior to remove the native fish from the area being treated and will create barriers. Contact the Department of Wildlife if there are any concerns.

Project Description

General Summary

- Site Acreage: 9.3 (portion)
- Project Type: Grocery store and gasoline station
- Number of Stories: 1
- Building Height (feet): 28 feet 6 inches
- Square Feet: 14,900 (grocery store)/5,800 (fuel canopy)/2,000 (truck fuel canopy)

Site Plan

The site plan depicts a proposed grocery store and a gasoline station on the northern half of the site. The applicant is proposing a fueling station with 16 gasoline pumps for vehicles on the west side of the subject property. Abutting the grocery store to the east will be a fueling station for trucks which will include 6 gasoline pumps. RV and truck parking is located east of the truck

fueling station. The site includes pedestrian walkways, bicycle parking, 61 vehicle stalls, and a trash enclosure. Access to the site is via a 50 foot driveway from Lewis Ranch Road.

Landscaping

The proposed landscaping will feature detached sidewalks along Lewis Ranch Road. The applicant is proposing 24 inch box trees which include Escarpment Oak, Mondell Pine, and Holly Oak trees throughout the site. Five gallon Coyote Brush and New Gold Lantana are proposed to be planted in between the trees. The landscape fingers will also be embellished with the proposed landscaping and meet the parking lot landscaping requirements.

Elevations

The elevation plan depicts a single story building with neutral colored exterior finishes that include sanded stucco, stone veneer, painted concrete panels, decorative foam rafters, horizontal metal siding, metal awnings, wall sconces, and decorative foam trim. The vehicle and truck fuel canopies are constructed of aluminum composite, which are supported by columns with stone veneer.

Floor Plans

The floor plan depicts a grocery store with a sales area of 10,500 square feet. The ancillary spaces to the grocery store include a cashier station, restrooms, back of house area, office, cooler/freezer space, beverage area, gaming area, electrical room, and a storage room.

Signage

Signage is not a part of this request.

Applicant's Justification

Per the applicant, the construction of the proposed grocery store and gasoline station will be an asset to the surrounding neighborhood and the general public who pass through the area. The proposed use is permitted in the C-2 (General Commercial) Zone, and improvements to the portion of the site that will be developed will improve the area aesthetically. The applicant implies that there are no adverse effects to the public safety and welfare of the individuals who work or live in the area.

STANDARDS FOR APPROVAL:

The applicant shall demonstrate that the proposed request meets the goals and purposes of Title 30.

Analysis

Current Planning

Waiver of Development Standards

According to Title 30, the applicant shall have the burden of proof to establish that the proposed request is appropriate for its existing location by showing that the uses of the area adjacent to the property included in the waiver of development standards request will not be affected in a substantially adverse manner. The intent and purpose of a waiver of development standards is to modify a development standard where the provision of an alternative standard, or other factors which mitigate the impact of the relaxed standard, may justify an alternative. Staff finds that the applicant is only developing half of the subject property. The applicant is willing to install full off-site improvements along Lewis Ranch Road including detached sidewalks and landscaping. The southern half of the property will remain vacant for future development and the unnamed portion of right-of-way to the south has not been developed.

Design Review

The overall design of the grocery store and gasoline station is architecturally compatible in color and exterior finish to the surrounding area. The applicant proposes exterior finishes that break up the monotonous figure of the building by layering aesthetically pleasing finishes. The landscaping design provides the site with visual buffers and proper circulation of pedestrians and vehicles/trucks. Staff is in support of the design review.

Public Works - Development Review

Waiver of Development Standards

Historical events have demonstrated how important off-site improvements are for drainage control. Additionally, improved streets beautify the community. Therefore, staff cannot support the Waiver of Development Standards for full off-site improvements.

Staff Recommendation

Approval of the design review, and denial of the waiver of development standards.

If this request is approved, the Board and/or Commission finds that the application is consistent with the standards and purpose enumerated in the Comprehensive Master Plan, Title 30, and/or the Nevada Revised Statutes.

PRELIMINARY STAFF CONDITIONS:
