**SAMPLE BALLOTS:**

All “[active](#)” registered voters will receive a sample ballot, regardless of political party affiliation. However, only voters registered as Democratic or Republican may vote in this election. Additionally, voters who registered on or after January 18, 2024, will not receive a sample ballot for the current election.

**ALL MAIL BALLOT ELECTION:**

All “[active](#)” voters who Registered as Democratic or Republican on or before January 23, 2024, will receive a mail ballot. However, those who submitted a “[Mail Ballot Preference Form](#)” by December 8, 2023, to opt-out of mail ballot voting will not receive a mail ballot.

**MAIL BALLOT DROP-OFF LOCATIONS: 170**

*NOTE: All [early voting sites](#) and [Election Day Vote Centers](#) will be mail ballot drop-off locations during their scheduled dates and hours of operation. [Some City Clerks’ offices and the Clark County Election Department](#) will also be available for mail ballot drop off from January 22 to February 6 (dates and times vary).*

**ELECTION DAY VOTE CENTERS: 127**

*NOTE: Instead of voting by mail, you may vote at any Vote Center you choose from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Election Day, no matter where you live or what your precinct is in Clark County. If you have your mail ballot with you, you must surrender it at the voting site. If you do not have your mail ballot with you and you had received it, you must sign an affirmation that you are not voting twice in the same election. Additionally, [same-day registration and updates](#) of existing registration are available at all Election Day Vote Centers.*

**EARLY VOTING SITES:**

Long-Term Sites (open at the same location for longer durations):	<b>19</b>
