

Information About the 2024 Primary Election

ELECTION DAY: June 11 (Tuesday)

EARLY VOTING: May 25 (Saturday) to June 7 (Friday)

A Primary Election is a preliminary (nominating) election to select (when necessary) Democratic, Republican, and nonpartisan candidates who will run in the General Election contests. Some, but not all, candidates in nonpartisan contests may be elected to office in a Primary Election if they receive more than 50% of the votes cast. In Nevada, State and Federal Primary Elections are "CLOSED," per NRS 293.257.

DEMOCRATIC PARTY VOTERS: If the party affiliation in your voter registration is Democratic, you may vote in your precinct's contests which select Democratic candidates AND in all of your precinct's nonpartisan contests in a Primary Election.

REPUBLICAN PARTY VOTERS: If the party affiliation in your voter registration is Republican, you may vote in your precinct's contests which select Republican candidates AND in all of your precinct's nonpartisan contests in a Primary Election.

ALL OTHER VOTERS: If the party affiliation in your voter registration is not Democratic or Republican, you may only vote in nonpartisan contests for your precinct in a Primary Election. Qualified minor party, other party, and independent (no party) candidates for partisan contests only appear in the General Election, not the Primary Election.

EARLY VOTING: October 19 (Saturday) to November 1 (Friday)
