You may only vote a paper provisional mail ballot. When you check-in to vote, you must show a current and valid (unexpired) Nevada Driver's License or Nevada State Identification card with a residential address that matches the one in your voter registration. If the address does not match or is not where you currently live, you must also show acceptable proof of residency. Voting options for persons with disabilities will also be available.
