
Permit Condition K

- Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan
- Permit Condition K
 - Acquire riparian lands to preserve as habitat for covered riparian birds
 - Muddy, Virgin Rivers and Meadow Valley Wash

6 covered riparian birds

- Summer tanager
- Blue grosbeak
- Arizona Bell's vireo
- Yellow billed cuckoo
- Southwestern willow flycatcher
- Vermillion flycatcher

Property Acquisition Activities

Land Acquisition

- Virgin River 2 Expansion
 - Acquired December 2014
 - 4 parcels
 - ~67 acres
 - ~88 contiguous parcels

Virgin River	101 acres
Virgin River expansion	67 acres
Meadow Valley Wash	_
TOTAL	286 acres

- Properties below Riverside Bridge
- Pending

Continue Property Evaluations

- Muddy River
 - Moapa area
 - 2 parcels, 20 acres
- Virgin River
 - Bunkerville area
 - 8 parcels, ~213 acres





Virgin River Activities

Limited Access

- Virgin River 1
 - Photo monitoring
 - Maintaining cattle exclusion fencing

Muddy River Activities

Continued Property Maintenance

- Weekly site visits and reports
- Minor fence maintenance
- Clean up
- Fire breaks
- Palm tree trimming
- Pond level



Continued Weed Management (NPS)

- Survey and map location and extent of weeds
- Treat annual and perennial weeds

Noxious Weeds

- Malta star thistle –high potential to expand
- Puncture vine
- Australian saltbush
- African mustard
- Russian knapweed



- Catastrophic flooding September 2014
 - Frog Refugia breached
 - Cancel Agreement with NDOW





Irrigation Ditch

Repaired bank under irrigation ditch

Installed and buried pipe full length of irrigation

canal

- Perkins Pilot Riparian project ~ 3 ACRES
 - Planning Phase
 - Geotechnical Assessment (Stillwater Sciences)
 - Soil cores
 - Depth to groundwater
 - Soil characterization
 - Groundwater well piezometers
 - Grading Plan
 - Construction Fiscal Year 2017
- Potential Upstream Terrace
 - ~12 acres
 - Incorporate high flow events





Perkins Pond

- ~ ½ acre
- Incorporate into the pilot site
- Nursery site

Future Steps - Riparian Reserves

- Initiate baseline bird surveys on Riparian Reserves
- Continue riparian property acquisition
- Website updates



Future Steps - Virgin River Reserve

- Initiate weed management/ botanical inventory on Virgin River
- Continue restoration Virgin River 1
 - Additional plantings
 - Monitoring
 - Fence improvements
- Restoration Project, Rd 15 SNPLMA



Future Steps - Muddy River

- Continue weed management and property maintenance projects
- Tamarisk control and restoration project
- Muddy River Restoration (SNPLMA 14)
 - Continue Perkins Pilot Riparian project
