The purpose of this project was to adopt the Assessment, Inventory, and Monitoring protocol to collect quantitative data and incorporate it with trends that occur across Clark County. Data collected will allow a better understanding of upland desert health throughout Clark County and enable the County to monitor trends at its reserve units. The information gathered will be used to improve the AIM implementation process in future years and serve as a resource for new implementation efforts.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

An AIM crew was established, consisting of one field lead and a technician. Sampling of 7 plots were done using AIM core methods during the 2023 field season. Data collection using this application was deemed an efficient method for collecting data and was provided to Clark County for review. Quality assurance and quality control were conducted by the crew successfully.
