DESERT CONSERVATION PROGRAM PROJECT COMPLETION SUMMARY Muddy River Habitat Restoration 2015-NATURAL-1570C

The work for the above referenced project has been completed. Below is a summary of project related information.

The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The purpose of this project was to prepare a restoration design that would provide high quality and resilient habitat for MSHCP covered riparian birds by creating and/or restoring habitat features and processes, that mimic unaltered systems and support a diverse vegetative community.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

A grading design and engineering plans for approximately 25 acres in Parcels A-E were completed which is intended to restore the hydraulic connection of the Muddy River floodplain to the existing river channel. A drainage study was submitted and approved by the Clark County Public Works Development Review and a Conditional Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR) was submitted to FEMA for approval.
