The work for the above referenced project has been completed. Below is a summary of project related information.

**The purpose of the above referenced project was:**

This ACE crew worked along the Virgin River restoring riparian habitat in partnership with the Clark County Desert Conservation Program in early 2021. The crew set out to plant native species in a masticated 40 acre parcel of land. While the restoration efforts focused on Southwestern Willow Flycatcher habitat, the Clark County Desert Conservation Program will also monitor native pollinator recruitment.

**The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:**

Riparian restoration including invasive species removal, fencing installation, and native species planting along the Virgin River Corridor in Clark County, Nevada.
