The purpose of this project was to monitor the effectiveness of Mojave Desert tortoise translocation at the Boulder City Conservation Easement.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

Monitoring was effectively completed for the first year of project number 2013-GBI-1412D. Twenty resident and 29 translocated tortoises were tracked weekly from March – October and monthly from November – February for a total of 1743 observations. 27 of the 49 radios were replaced during this period.
