The work for the above reference project has been completed. Below is a summary of project related information.

The purpose of the above referenced project was:

The goal of the avian surveys project was to verify and expand upon records of seven target avian species across Clark County in order to refine habitat suitability models. The seven target species were golden eagle (*Aquila chrysaetos*), burrowing owl (*Athene cunicularia*), gilded flicker (*Colaptes chrysoides*), loggerhead shrike (*Lanius ludovicianus*), Bendire's thrasher (*Toxostoma bendirei*), LeConte's thrasher (*Toxostoma lecontei*), and Bell's vireo (*Vireo bellii*).

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

- Identified and successfully surveyed 30 sites during 2021 and 2022 consecutive years.
- Surveys suggested validation of habitat suitability models for golden eagle, LeConte's thrasher, and loggerhead shrike.
