The work for the above reference project has been completed. Below is a summary of project related information.

The purpose of the above referenced project was:

Surveys were conducted to establish a record of small mammal species present within the riparian reserve units managed by Clark County along the Muddy River and Virgin River. The information collected during this project acts as a baseline record to track changes in the small mammal species composition in the riparian units and measure the success of future management and restoration activities to be conducted in the area.

The major accomplishments or findings of this project include:

Conducted and completed small mammal surveys in the Muddy River property and Mormon Mesa, Riverside, Bunkerville West, Bunkerville East, and Mesquite West sites that make up the Virgin River property. The data collected was used to develop a small mammal species inventory list for the riparian reserve units.
