- Students in select third through fifth grade classrooms completed written and drawing assessments to ascertain to what degree they accomplished some of the intended student learning outcomes.
- Teachers responded to a survey and participated in focus groups to further discuss their program experience and share ideas for the future.
- Analysis of the data identified that overall the program is effective, with just a few key takeaways to consider in the future design and implementation of the Mojave Max program.
