The ten covered plant species include: Mokiak Milkvetch, Virgin River Thistle, Hoffman's Cryptantha, Unusual Cat's-eye, Chalk Liveforever, Silver Leaf Sunray, Las Vegas Buckwheat, Leconte's Barrel Cactus, Beaver Dam Breadroot, and Rosy Two-Tone Beardtongue

The purpose of the above referenced project are:

The main objectives for the project were to gain information about the locations and population sizes of ten plant species and to prioritize these species and their habitats for status re-assessments in future phases of the Clark County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan.

The major accomplishment or findings of this project include:

- Developed statistically sound monitoring protocols for each of ten watch species.
- Developed conceptual models of environmental requirements and stressors for each of ten watch species.
- Appended a geospatial database with new and known survey locations.
- Documented two new populations of Virgin River Thistle.
- Documented one new location of Las Vegas Beardtongue.
- Documented 16 new locations of Rosy Two-Tone Beardtongue.
- Surveyed and found many new populations of Silver Leaf Sunray.
- Several new populations of Chalk Liveforever were recorded
