

**TERMINATION OF DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY**

**PROCLAMATION OF THE CLARK COUNTY MANAGER TERMINATING  
THE DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY IN THE COUNTY OF  
CLARK, NEVADA**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes Chapter 414 and Clark County Code Chapter 3.04, on August 20, 2023, the County Manager declared a state of emergency due to anticipated historic rainfall and potential for significant flooding events in Clark County from the impacts of Hurricane Hilary; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 20, 2023, and August 21, 2023, Clark County experienced significant flooding events from weather events created by storms related to Hurricane Hilary especially in the rural areas of Clark County; and

**WHEREAS**, the conditions causing the declared state of emergency no longer exist and are now within the control of Clark County's normal protective services, personnel, equipment and facilities; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, pursuant to Clark County Code 3.04.060, the County Manager of the County of Clark, State of Nevada does hereby terminate this state of emergency.
