

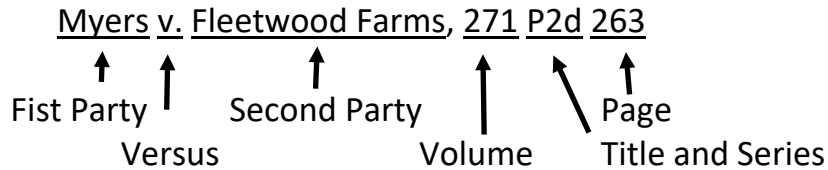

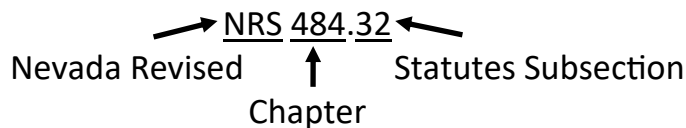


Legal Citations

Legal Citations direct you to the volume, book, and page you need to find a case, law, or discussion relating to a legal issue. A legal citation for a case may appear as: Myers v. Fleetwood Farms, 271 P2d 263. This citation contains five parts: two party names, a volume number, the title, a series number, and the page number.



This case is located in volume 271 of the Pacific Reporter 2nd on page 263. Cases often provide more than one citation, denoting that the case is available in more than one location. Citations for laws are similar, but contain fewer parts. Chapters are marked on the spine to direct you to the book you need. A citation for a Nevada Law will appear in this format:
