SNHD celebrates American Heart Month



February is **American Heart Month**, and the Southern Nevada Health District and community partners are offering free programs and classes to help people reduce their risk factors for heart disease.

- Heart disease and stroke are the first and fifth leading causes of death in the United States, respectively.
- Every 43 seconds, someone in the U.S. has a heart attack, and every four minutes, someone dies from a stroke.
- In 2022, cardiovascular disease accounted for 702,880 deaths in the U.S., with heart disease and stroke claiming more lives than all forms of cancer and chronic lower respiratory disease combined.

Applications Due FEBRUARY 7

Receive professional training to become a **Basic EMT at no cost to you.**
Program participants will learn about a career as an EMT through a two-week bootcamp.

A select number of participants will join the EMT Academy cohort for a **nine-week training program** and will leave with the skills and certifications needed for a career in Emergency Medical Services.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE:

- 18 years or older
- High school diploma or GED equivalent
- No felony convictions
- Nevada ID or driver's license
- Must pass a drug test, including no cannabis

KEY PROGRAM DATES:

- Applications are due **February 7**
- Bootcamp begins on **March 3**
- Academy begins on **April 7**
