On October 5, we are celebrating the Nellis Meadows BMX Track 40th Anniversary Celebration.

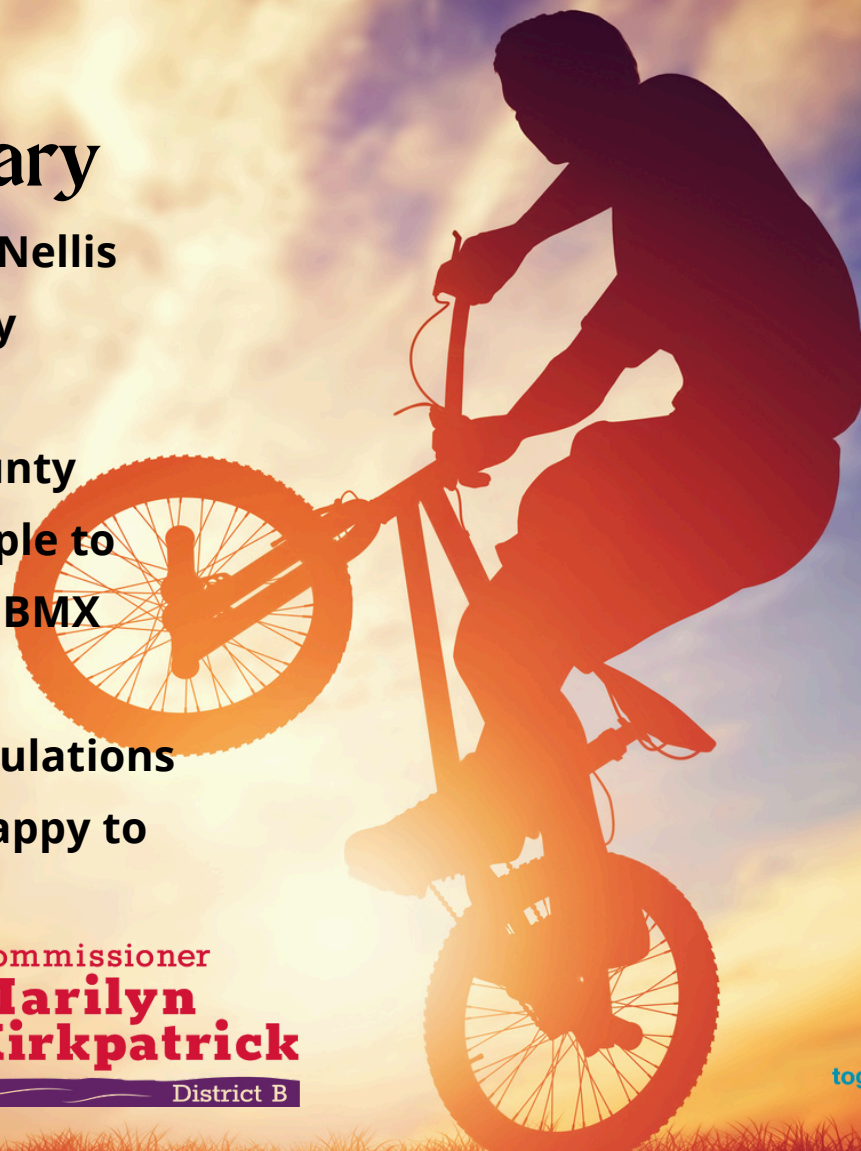
This park has been a staple in our county providing a safe environment for people to build a special community and enjoy BMX biking activities.

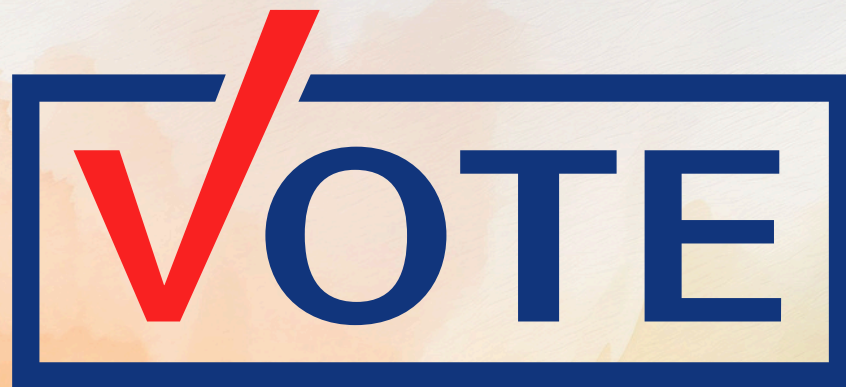
