- Committee recommendation if less funding is awarded than estimated
 - If the award is less than estimated the subawards are to be recalculated according to their percentages from the amounts designated using the estimated award.

RECALCULATED ALLOCATIONS

- A clerical error was discovered in preparation for the CDAC meeting.
- Available funding for Homeless Prevention was estimated to be \$539,697 during deliberation but \$576,711 is the more accurate estimation.
- Funding recommendations were adjusted according to the contingency plan laid out by the ad-hoc committee during the meeting.
 - The award for SAFE House was increased to fully fund their request.
 - The remainder was used to increase the awards for Emergency Aid of Boulder City, The Cupcake Girls, The Salvation Army, and Vegas Stronger.
