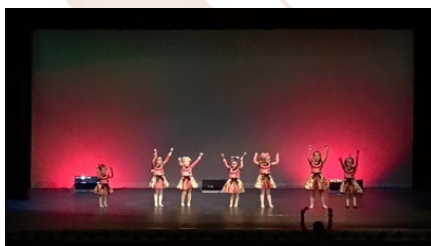

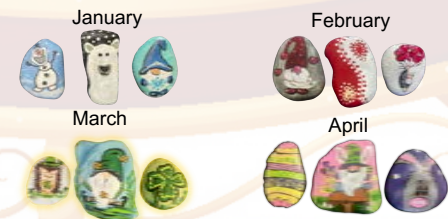

Setup and cleanup are the renter's responsibility and should be conducted during the reservation times the renter requests. Any Decorations put up by the renter must be removed. All garbage cans tables & chairs used for the said event must be cleaned & put on carts.

Smoking and consumption of alcoholic beverages are not permitted anywhere within Bunkerville Community Center. Violation of Facilities rules will result in the ending of the rental, and forfeit of the Cleaning Deposit.

bounce houses and children's amusement rides require a two million dollar liability insurance with Clark County as an insured. if indemnity insurance is not received the reservation will be canceled.

Facility Staff will open and close at the times stated on the reservation paperwork/Receipt. No split times will be reserved, reservations must be one continuous block.
