Jordan Bunker reported on current water levels. There have been no major leaks or breaks in the last two months.

Josh Travers reported that the Calico Basin Recreational Area Management Plan is still in process and the end date has been extended to December 31, 2021. Final draft will be presented for Public Opinion in October. The Legacy Trail design is at approximately 70% complete with an anticipated Public Opinion review in early November. Phase 1 construction could possibly begin mid 2022 dependent on public feedback. An OAG grant of \$75k has been given to "Friends of Red Rock" for work in Cottonwood Valley. Plans to be developed in the near future.

Meggan Holzer reported that Gypsum Resources Use Permit and Tentative Map has been approved by the Clark County Commissioners.
