**SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT CDBG-CV and ESG-CV**

Amendment of the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG-CV)  
for the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act of 2020

The purpose of this first Amendment of the Clark County Substantial Amendment to the 2020 Action Plan is to revise the ESG-CV spending plan to fund eligible Rapid Rehousing activities. Clark County Community Resources Management (CRM) is proposing to reprogram \$2,074,703 ESG-CV funds for rapid rehousing activities in response to Covid-19 related housing needs including homeless households which are highly vulnerable to poor outcomes.
