History & Request

The site is home to several office uses currently, along with various retail shops, warehouses, and a day spa. The site was approved for an office in a specific suite within the building via UC-24-0382. Now, the applicant is requesting a use permit to allow more offices and to allow office as a principal use for the entire site.

Site Plans

The plans depict a commercial/industrial building that is set back 59 feet from Sammy Davis Jr. Drive and 13.5 feet from the north property line. Access to the site is via Sammy Davis Jr. Drive with 2 existing driveways on the east side of the property, along with cross access with the property to the north and via a cross access driveway to the south. There are parking areas provided in front of the building and in the rear of the site behind the building. A trash enclosure is also located in the northeast corner of the site. The proposed office is located in the southeast corner of the building, with direct entry from the parking lot in front of the building.

Landscaping

The plans and photos provided depict an existing landscape strip along Sammy Davis Jr. Drive with various shrubs. There are no proposed changes to landscaping associated with this application.

Elevations

The plans depict an existing 2 story building that was originally constructed in 1962 and updated in 2013, which includes painted block construction with stone veneer accents along the frontage.

Floor Plans

The plans provided depict an existing 2 story building with various office suites and retail locations throughout.

Applicant's Justification

The applicant has stated that they wish to obtain a use permit to allow offices throughout their entire building so as to avoid more use permits for future tenants. The applicant also states the site has adequate parking per its existing uses, and that allowing a use permit for offices throughout the site would not negatively impact their on-site parking.

STANDARDS FOR APPROVAL:

The applicant shall demonstrate that the proposed request is consistent with the Master Plan and is in compliance with Title 30.

Analysis

Comprehensive Planning

A special use permit is considered on a case by case basis in consideration of the standards for approval. Additionally, the use shall not result in a substantial or undue adverse effect on adjacent properties, character of the neighborhood, traffic conditions, parking, public improvements, public sites or right-of-way, or other matters affecting the public health, safety, and general welfare; and will be adequately served by public improvements, facilities, and services, and will not impose an undue burden.

Although the site was originally developed for industrial uses, staff finds that it has since added several commercial uses, including a day spa and liquor store. Moreover, this site has historically been used as a location for outcall services, and many outcall promoters still use the site to conduct business operations today. Per the updated version of Title 30; however, outcall is now covered under the ‘office’ use. For this reason, the applicant was recently approved for an office use via UC-24-0382 within a specific suite in the building.

Staff finds that further office uses will be consistent with the existing uses on-site and will be complementary to the other businesses in the area. Just to the southwest, parcel 162-09-203-006 completed ZC-23-0478 in September of last year to change their zoning from IL to CG to

accommodate offices and other commercial uses. Additionally, the addition of an office use for the entire building would help the applicant and their tenants avoid future permitting and promote new business development within the area. Lastly, staff finds that the parking on-site is generally sufficient for the uses listed in the parking analysis provided; the recently adopted version of Title 30 dictates that the property has an extra 6 parking spaces available for future tenants. For these reasons, staff can support this request.

Staff Recommendation
