

ELECTION WORKERS NEEDED FOR 2024

The Clark County Election Department needs Poll Workers for 2024. With three elections expected during the calendar year, the Election Department prefers prospective employees who can work all three elections, during the Early Voting periods and on Election Days. The department especially needs workers who are fluent in Spanish, Filipino/Tagalog, or Mandarin.

- When:**
- (Possible) Presidential Preference Primary (PPP) - Early Voting is from Jan. 27 to Feb. 2, 2024, and Election Day is Feb. 6, 2024.
 - Regular Primary Election – Early Voting is from May 25 to June 7, 2024, and Election Day is June 11, 2024.
 - General Election – Early Voting from Oct. 19 to Nov. 1, 2024, and Election Day is Nov. 5, 2024.

- Pay:**
- Election Day poll workers receive a flat rate of \$200 for the day.
 - Early voting poll workers are paid \$17 per hour.
 - Workers who are required to attend training will receive \$50 for the class.

Requirements: All poll workers must meet all of the requirements below:

- Be a registered voter in Clark County, NV, or, be enrolled in High School and at least 16 years of age.
- Not be a candidate or relative of a candidate for nomination or election in 2024.
- Not be a poll watcher or observer during any election you work.
- Successfully complete the Election Department's training if required.
