RE: IMPACT OF COVID-19 ON LOCAL BUSINESSES

To Business Licensees:

On March 12, 2020, the Governor of the State of Nevada issued a Declaration of Emergency due to the spread of the COVID-19 virus in Nevada, and on March 20, 2020, the Governor issued Directive 003 mandating that all non-essential businesses close and that all essential businesses must adopt COVID-19 risk mitigation measures that reduce the risk of community disease spread.

The County realizes the significant and, in many cases, devastating impact this has on local businesses. Therefore, the Department of Business License is taking the following steps to mitigate the economic effects on businesses:

1. Penalties and late fees will not be assessed on business license fees that become due during April, May or June 2020 (this may be extended);
2. The status of the business license will be not be changed to Delinquent status for license fees that become due during April, May or June 2020 (this may be extended);
3. Collaborate with business owners to allow payment plans for renewal fees; and
4. No disciplinary action for business license fee payments submitted after the due date.

The Department of Business License is committed to working with small business owners and other businesses through these difficult times and it is our desire that we can all get back to business as soon as the Declaration of Emergency is rescinded.
