2021 BOULDER CITY MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

The only elections currently scheduled for 2021 are the Boulder City Municipal Elections and will be conducted in the same manner as the 2020 Elections. Municipal Elections (Primary and General) are NONPARTISAN. Only voters registered in Boulder City may vote in the 2021 municipal elections. All active registered Boulder City voters will receive a mail ballot, whether or not it was requested. Voters will also have in-person voting options, including early voting. Registered Voters who do not receive their mail ballot by March 15th, should contact us at (702) 455-VOTE. WE STRONGLY ENCOURAGE VOTERS TO MAIL THEIR BALLOT rather than drop off in-person. REGISTRATION AND VOTING SCHEDULE

PRIMARY ELECTION:

- March 9th – Standard Close of Primary Registration
- March 10th to 23rd – Standard Online Registration
- April 1st – Same Day Online Registration Deadline
- March 25th to April 2nd - Early Voting
- April 6th – Primary Election Day

GENERAL ELECTION:

- May 18th – Standard Close of General Registration
- May 19th to June 1st – Standard Online Registration
- June 10th – Same Day Online Registration Deadline
- June 3rd to June 11th - Early Voting
- June 15th – General Election Day

2021 Notice of Intent Form is Due May 16, 2021

Please mark your calendars to return your completed 2021 Notice of Intent form to the Election Department by May 16, 2021. I have included the 2021 Notice of Intent form with this newsletter, the Notice of Intent form can also be downloaded from our website under "Forms for Field Registrars" section at: https://www.clarkcountynv.gov/government/departments/elections/forms_and_info_flyers.php - Completed and signed Notice of Intent forms can be returned via email, mail or faxed to (702)455-2981, but please confirm receipt. Should you decide not to continue as a Field Registrar, you must return your badge and all unused applications to the Election Department **immediately**. You can either deliver your badge and supplies in person by appointment only or mail in your Field Registrar materials by **certified mail**. ****Pursuant to NRS 293.505, all Field Registrars are required to complete the Notice of Intent form and it must be received in our office by the deadline as listed above. (Five days after any Close of General Registration).*

Field Registrar Badges Expire June 30, 2021

Due to the current COVID-19 restrictions and to comply with state regulations and guidelines, the Election Department will not be conducting any voter registration training classes at this time. All Field Registrar badges expire on June 30, 2021 and you will not be able to register voters as a Field Registrar volunteer with the Election Department once your badge expires. **I will continue to keep you posted on classes and procedures as information is received. Once the legislative session ends in June, I will let you know the requirements to updating and renewing your existing Field Registrar badge. It will depend on the outcome of the 2021 legislative session.**

*Starting in 2022, all incorporated cities in Clark County (Boulder City, Henderson, Las Vegas, Mesquite, and North Las Vegas) will consolidate their municipal election with Federal/State Elections in even-numbered years.
