Position Requirements (Pay includes training class). Pay is received approximately 4 weeks after the election. There is no reimbursement for mileage.

- Senior Monitor (Pay \$270): Ability to stand and walk around for most of the day is required. Ability to lift 25 lbs. and tape electrical cords to the floor.
- Poll Book Operator (Pay \$250): Good computer skills are required; ability to process voters on a laptop computer.
- Voting Machine Monitor (Pay \$250): Ability to stand and walk around for most of the day is required.
