The work for the above referenced project has been completed. Please see the attached for all project related information.

**The purpose of the above referenced project was:**

A priority for the Clark County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP) is to take proactive steps to reduce the likelihood of future species or critical habitat listings by funding projects that provide protection and restoration of habitat for species at risk. The upper Muddy River has the highest concentration of riparian species in Clark County that are endangered and/or regarded as species of concern. The upper fifteen miles of the Muddy River watershed are primarily in private, corporate, or tribal ownership. Recent acquisitions by The Nature Conservancy (TNC) of the Alamo, Shirley Perkins, and Henrie properties (herein after referred to as Properties) have added a small but strategic number of acres.

**The major accomplishment or findings of this project include:**

- Salt Cedar removed from properties (one treatment)
- Demolition of Alamo house to start restoration
- Preparation and use of pond for Relict Leopard Frogs
