The Presiding Judge of the Laughlin Justice Court has various responsibilities, such as supervising the administrative business of the Court, ensuring the quality and continuity of court services, supervising the court calendar, ensuring the court's duties are performed in a timely and orderly manner and otherwise facilitating the business of the Court.

On March 12, 2020, Governor Steve Sisolak direction in his "For Nevada Stay Home" announcement on March 17, 2020 and the DC's recommendations regarding social distancing the Laughlin Justice court find it necessary to modify its prior Administrator Order No. 20-01 with respect to Landlord/Tenant cases. The Court is suspending all Landlord/Tenant cases until April 21, 2020. All cases of this type currently set for trial are hereby continued until April 29, 2020 (subject to further order should circumstances change).

The Administrative Order shall be reviewed no later than every thirty (30) days and shall continue until modified or rescinded by a subsequent order.
