8 The Presiding Judge of the Boulder Township Justice Court has various
9 responsibilities, including supervising the administrative business of the Justice Court,
10 ensuring the quality and continuity of court services, supervising the court calendar, and
11 insuring the court's duties are timely and orderly performed and otherwise facilitating
12 the business of the Justice Court.

14 In light of the Governor's direction in his "For Nevada Stay Home"
15 announcement on March 17, 2020 and the CDC's recommendations regarding social
16 distancing the Boulder City Justice Court finds it necessary to modify its prior
17 Administrative Order No. 20-01 with respect to Landlord/Tenant cases. The Court is
18 suspending all Landlord/Tenant cases for thirty (30) days (April 20, 2020). All cases of
19 this type currently set for trial are hereby continued until April 21, 2020 at 1:00 pm
20 (subject to further order should circumstances change).

22 This Administrative Order shall be reviewed no later than every thirty (30) days
23 and shall continue until modified or rescinded by a subsequent order.
