10 WHEREAS, Local Rules of Practice for the Justice Court of North Las Vegas
11 Township, rule 6.5 (b) (2) empowers the Chief Judge to be responsible for the administration of
12 court rules and regulations; and

13 WHEREAS, On March 12, 2020, Governor Steve Sisolak declared a state of emergency
14 in Nevada in response to the recent outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19). Given the
15 severity of the risk posed to the public by COVID-19, and after consultation with Nevada
16 Supreme Court Chief Justice Kristina Pickering, the Chief Judge of the North Las Vegas Justice
17 Court has determined that alterations to court procedure are necessary for the protection of the
18 community; and

19 WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, Nevada Supreme Court Chief Justice Kristina
20 Pickering and the North Las Vegas Justice Court issued Administrative Order #2020-02 wherein
21 it set forth on page 2, effective March 17, 2020, all deadline and default provisions contained in
22 NRS Chapter 40 concerning eviction and unlawful detainer proceedings are suspended and
23 stayed;

25 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that forcible entry and forcible detainer actions, as defined
26 by NRS 40.230 and 40.240, and the procedures set forth in NRS 40.412-40.416, are not covered
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1 by Administrative Order #2020-02, as that order is limited to eviction and unlawful detainer
2 proceedings under NRS Chapter 40.

3 In addition, any landlord, real property owner, or property manager may, by written ex
4 parte motion filed with the Court by facsimile or email, seek leave of Court for exemption from
5 Administrative Order #2020-02. Exemptions will only be granted when the asserted basis for the
6 unlawful detainer action constitutes a danger to the community or is otherwise an emergency.
7 This provision specifically excludes no-cause notices under NRS 40.251 and non-payment of
8 rent notices under NRS 40.2512 and NRS 118B.190 (1)(c) which will not be considered for
9 exemption.
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
11 The following motions and actions related to unlawful detainer actions are deemed
12 essential:
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- 14 1. Motions to Retrieve Essential Items
- 15 2. Motions to Contest Personal Property Liens
- 16 3. Complaints for Expedited Relief for Illegal Lockout or Termination of Essential Services
