Photography Rules

Per Clark County Code of Ordinances persons who take photographs and/or shoot film or motion pictures in Clark County Museum for commercial purposes are required to have a film permit issued by Clark County Department of Business License. "Commercial" photography means photography that is meant for financial gain. If you are being paid to take photographs or are paying someone to take photographs you need a permit. If you are not a commercial photographer and would like to take photos for your personal use, please follow the following rules.

- Admission fees must be paid for each person.
- Use of any area of the museum is limited to our operation hours of 9:00am -4:30pm.
- Suggestive attire such as underwear, negligees, open garments, and nudity are prohibited.
- Do not block sidewalks, roads, doorway, ramps, or paths.
- No flash photography inside any of the buildings.
- Close all doors when entering and exiting buildings.
- Do not handle, move, or touch any object or display they are not photography props. This includes house, furnishings, vehicles, and equipment on the grounds.
- Do not climb or sit on rocks, trees, signs, fences, barriers, vehicles, or buildings.
