Re: Temporary disconnects inside NVEnergy easement

Dear: Clark County,

This letter is to affirm that NV Energy holds certain land rights (easements, etc.) to access, construct, operate and maintain our utility facilities on private property. In instances where limited work must be performed inside the boundaries of these areas to accommodate the completion of a temporary disconnect and reconnect (TDR) and/or to maintain customer-owned services, NV Energy may grant the customer the right to complete such work through an established process. No formal design or grant of easement will be issued in these instances.

This statement is not intended to grant any customer permission to place freestanding facilities inside NV Energy easements, but only to clarify that that customers may perform basic substructure work inside NV Energy easements in order to complete an approved temporary disconnect and reconnect.
